
Honorable Members of the Commission:

I have lived in Manila all my life and presently own and live in my own home with my significant other. I am thirty four years old. I have known Dendra Dengler since I was three years old when she was my preschool teacher. It has come to my attention that Ms. Dengler is being charged with conflict of interest regarding an action while serving our community. This action was to provide for public ownership of unique and rare natural resources - coastal dune habitat – between the community and the beach and ocean. I believe the action has provided needed public access for residents of the community of Manila and the people of the State of California.

As a homeowner of property bordering very closely to these parklands, I am concerned that I may never be able to hold office in view of your potential decision, penalizing Ms. Dengler for acting on behalf of our community. If good citizens like Ms. Dengler can be culpable for acting in the interest of our community, then I could never serve in an elected office in my local community, since any actions I might vote on regarding the beach and dunes could be considered a violation. This would mean that I would not be able to represent my community on most of the issues relevant to my community.

Thank you for your careful attention to my concerns regarding this situation. In the interest of justice, I hope that you will decide to look kindly on her action.
