Forms, Manuals and Other Materials

The division is in the process of updating 14 forms to incorporate changes in the law as a result of Assemblymember Gordon's bill - AB 594. The bill, among other things, increases the committee qualification threshold from \$1,000 to \$2,000 and eliminates some duplicative reports. The forms are expected to be completed by the end of the year at which time our focus will turn to updating the campaign manuals.

Filing Schedules

Staff has updated and reposted the 15 filing schedules for state and local primary 2016 elections to reflect the recent changes to the law and will have the general election filing schedules posted in December.
