During the period of December 2, 2015 through January 6, 2016, the Enforcement Division received 59 referrals and complaints as detailed in the chart below.

Also during this time, the Division closed a total of 78 cases including:

- 38 warning letters,
- 16 no violation letters.
- 22 as a result of the adoption of stipulations and defaults at the December Commission meeting, and
- 2 committees were administratively terminated.

The Division had 885 cases in various stages of resolution at the time of the December Monthly Report and currently has 848 cases in various stages of resolution, including the 46 cases before the Commission as listed in the January 2016 agenda.

To give an overview of all cases within the Enforcement Division, in addition to the numbers provided above, below is a second chart to track the outcome of the 2,460 \$50 Annual Fee referrals that the Enforcement Division received from the Secretary of State's office on May 1, 2015.
