5	(a) Making or participating in making a governmental decision shall not include:
6	(1) Actions of public officials which are solely ministerial, secretarial, manual, or
7	clerical;
8	(2) Appearances by a public official as a member of the general public before an agency
9	in the course of its prescribed governmental function to represent himself or herself on matters
10	related solely to the official's personal interests as defined in Title 2, California Code of
11	Regulations, section 18702.4(b)(1); or
12	(3) Actions by public officials relating to their compensation or the terms or conditions of
13	their employment or contract. In the case of public officials who are "consultants," as defined in
14	Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 18701(a)(2), this includes actions by consultants
15	relating to the terms or conditions of the contract pursuant to which they provide services to the
16	agency, so long as they are acting in their private capacity.
17	(b) Notwithstanding Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 18702.3(a), an
18	official is not attempting to use his or her official position to influence a governmental decision
19	of an agency covered by that subsection if the official:
20	(1) Appears in the same manner as any other member of the general public before an
21	agency in the course of its prescribed governmental function solely to represent himself or
22	herself on a matter which is related to his or her personal interests. An official's "personal
23	interests" include, but are not limited to:
24	(A) An interest in real property which is wholly owned by the official or members of his
25	or her immediate family.
26	(B) A business entity wholly owned by the official or members of his or her immediate
27	family.
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1	(C) A business entity over which the official exercises sole direction and control, or over
2	which the official and his or her spouse jointly exercise sole direction and control.
3	(2) Communicates with the general public or the press.
4	(3) Negotiates his or her compensation or the terms and conditions of his or her
5	employment or contract.
6	(4) Prepares drawings or submissions of an architectural, engineering or similar nature to be used
7	by a client in connection with a proceeding before any agency. However, this provision applies
8	only if the official has no other direct oral or written contact with the agency with regard to the
9	client's proceeding before the agency except for necessary contact with agency staff concerning
10	the processing or evaluation of the drawings or submissions prepared by the official.
11	(5) Appears before a design or architectural review committee or similar body of which he or she
12	is a member to present drawings or submissions of an architectural, engineering or similar nature
13	which the official has prepared for a client if the following three criteria are met:
14	(A) The review committee's sole function is to review architectural or engineering plans
15	or designs and to make recommendations in that instance concerning those plans or designs to a
16	planning commission or other agency;
17	(B) The ordinance or other provision of law requires that the review committee include
18	architects, engineers or persons in related professions, and the official was appointed to the body
19	to fulfill this requirement; and
20	(C) The official is a sole practitioner.
21	(c) Academic Decisions
22	(1) Except as provided in subsection (c)(2), neither disclosure of financial interests nor
23	disqualification is required under Government Code sections 87100, 87302, or any Conflict of
24	Interest Code, in connection with:
25	(A) Teaching decisions, including the selection by a teacher of books or other educational
26	materials for use within his or her own school or institution, and other decisions incidental to
27	teaching;
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(B) Decisions made by a person who has teaching or research responsibilities at an
institution of higher education to pursue personally a course of academic study or research, to
apply for funds to finance such a project, to allocate financial and material resources for such
academic study or research, and all decisions relating to the manner or methodology with which
such study or research will be conducted. Provided, however, that the provisions of this
subsection (c)(1)(B) shall not apply with respect to any decision made by the person in the
exercise of institution or campus wide administrative responsibilities respecting the approval or
review of any phase of academic research or study conducted at that institution or campus.

(2) Disclosure (consistent with 2 Cal. Code Regs. section 18755) shall be required under Government Code section 87302 or any Conflict of Interest Code in connection with a decision made by a person or persons at an institution of higher education with principal responsibility for a research project to undertake such research, if it is to be funded or supported, in whole or in part, by a contract or grant (or other funds earmarked by the donor for a specific research project or for a specific researcher) from a nongovernmental entity, but disqualification may not be required under Government Code sections 87100, 87302 or any Conflict of Interest Code in connection with any such decision if the decision is substantively reviewed by an independent committee established within the institution. The financial effect of a governmental decision on the source of a gift to a public official, as identified in Section 87103(e), is material if:

- (a) The source is a claimant, applicant, respondent, contracting party, or is otherwise named or identified as the subject of the proceeding; or
- (b) The source is an individual that will be financially affected under the standards applied to an official in Regulation 18705.5 18702.5, or the official knows or has reason to know that the individual has an interest in a business entity or real property that will be financially affected under the standards applied to a financial interest in Regulation 18705.1 or 18705.2, 18702.1 or 18702.2, respectively; or

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- 2 (c) The source is a nonprofit that will receive a measurable financial benefit or loss, or
- 3 the official knows or has reason to know that the nonprofit has an interest in real property that
- 4 will be financially affected under the standards applied to a financial interest in Regulation
- 5 18705.2 18702.5; or
- 6 (d) The source is a business entity that will be financially affected under the standards as
- 7 applied to a financial interest in Regulation 18705.1 18702.1.
