- 3 (a) The payment of salary, reimbursement for personal expenses, or other compensation
- 4 by an employer to an employee who spends more than 10% of his <u>or her</u> compensated time in
- 5 any one month rendering services for political purposes is a contribution, as defined in Section
- 6 82015 and Regulation 18215, or an expenditure, as defined in Section 82025 and Regulation
- $7 \frac{18225}{1}$, by the employer if:

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- (1) The employee renders services at the request or direction of the employer; or
- 9 (2) The employee, with consent of the employer, is relieved of any normal working
- 10 responsibilities related to his <u>or her</u> employment in order to render the personal services, unless
- the employee engages in political activity on bona fide, although compensable, vacation time or
- pursuant to a uniform policy allowing employees to engage in political activity.
- 13 (b) Personal services are rendered for political purposes if they are carried on for the
- purpose of influencing or attempting to influence the action of the voters for or against the
- 15 nomination or election of one or more candidates, or the qualification or passage of any measure,
- and include but are not limited to:
 - (1) Personal services received by or made at the behest of a candidate or committee by an
- 18 employee; and

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- 19 (2) Hours spent developing or distributing communications that expressly advocate the
- 20 election or defeat of a clearly identified candidate or the qualification, passage or defeat of a
- 21 clearly identified measure.
- (c) The amount of the contribution or expenditure reportable pursuant to this regulation is
- 23 the pro-rata portion of the gross salary, reimbursement for personal expenses or compensation

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- 1 attributable to the time spent on political activity. An in-kind contribution of the services of
- 2 salaried personnel to a committee and the expenditure by the person making the salary payment
- 3 are considered to be made on the payroll date of the salaried personnel.
- 4 (d) This regulation does not affect the obligation of an employer or any other person to
- 5 report expenditures and contributions other than the salary, reimbursement for personal
- 6 expenses, or compensation for personal services of an employee.
- 7 (e) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (a), salary, reimbursement for personal
- 8 expenses and compensation paid to an employee by an employer who has contracted to provide
- 9 services to a candidate or committee are not contributions or expenditures by the employer,
- provided that the services rendered by the employee are not beyond the scope of the contract.
- 11 This paragraph does not affect any reporting obligation imposed by Section 84303.
