This includes, but is not limited to advertisements 11 in electronic messages, electronic message attachments, text messages, or advertisements that 12 appear on Internet <u>websites or</u> webpages, <u>social media</u>, blogs, <u>mobile devices</u>, or other <u>generally</u> 13 accessible electronic communication systems.

14 (3) A telephone, facsimile, or electronic message media communication addressed to 15 recipients, such as electronic messages and text messages, that is not solicited by the recipient 16 and is intended for delivery in substantially similar form to more than 200 recipients. For 17 purposes of this paragraph, this includes when a committee sends a message to 200 or fewer 18 recipients and the message is "forwarded" to other persons by a recipient, the message sent by 19 the committee is not an advertisement by that committee unless the recipient forwarded the any 20 message forwarded at the behest of the committee and where more than 200 total recipients 21 received receive the message.

(4) A direct mailing that is not solicited by the recipient and is intended for delivery in
substantially similar form to more than 200 recipients.

- 4 of establishing that a disclaimer could not be included due to the above factors.
