§ 18531. Return of Excessive Contributions.

(a) A committee may return a contribution, or a portion thereof, that exceeds an
applicable contribution limit to the contributor within 14 days of receiving the contribution
without violating the contribution limits set forth in Sections 85301, 85302, and 85303, so long
as the committee does not have actual knowledge the contribution exceeds the limit at the time of
receipt, or make use of the contribution prior to returning it. Contributions which either in the
aggregate or on their face exceed the contribution limits of Government Code Sections 85301,
85302 and 85303 shall be deemed not to have been accepted within the meaning of that
provision, if returned pursuant to this section.

- (b) For purposes of subdivision (a), a committee makes use of a monetary contribution if, after receiving the contribution, it makes expenditures exceeding what the committee's available cash balance would be had it not received the contribution that exceeds the applicable contribution limit. A monetary contribution shall be returned prior to deposit or negotiation, within 14 days of receipt.
- (c) A non-monetary contribution shall may be returned to the contributor within the deadline prescribed in subdivision (a) either in its original form, or in a monetary equivalent greater than or equal to the amount by which its value exceeds an applicable contribution limit. by returning to the contributor, within the deadline specified in subdivision (b) any of the following:
- 21 (1) The non-monetary contribution.
- 22 (2) Its monetary equivalent.

- (d) This regulation shall not be construed to authorize the making or solicitation of any contribution in excess of the contribution limits of Government Code Sections 85301, 85302 and 85303.
- (e) Notwithstanding <u>subsections</u> <u>subdivisions</u> (a) through (c), contributions to a committee, other than a candidate controlled committee, which are earmarked for purposes other than making contributions directly to candidates for elective office shall not be deemed in excess of limits and need not be returned, provided the contributions are deposited to a separate account within the deadline prescribed in <u>subsection</u> (b) <u>subdivision</u> (a).
- (f) A contribution, returned, in whole or in part, under this regulation, must be reported as a contribution in its entirety pursuant to Chapter 4 of the Act if the committee deposits the contribution in its bank account. The amount returned to the contributor must be reported as an expenditure.
