Enforcement Division Priorities and Procedures

Streamline Settlement Program

The Enforcement Division analyzes and processes over 1,500 complaints per year. In order to focus its resources on cases concerning serious violations of the Act, the Enforcement Division created a Streamline Settlement Program for prosecution of those violations with a lesser degree of public harm.

Per Commissioner Hatch's request, the Commission addressed the Program at its March meeting. As a follow up to that discussion, the Commission is seeking public comment regarding the program.
