			<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Contributions: State/County committees making contributions in connection with a local election held on June 7, 2011 are not required to file pre-election reports outlined in Government Code Section 84200.5. As noted below, such committees must file the late contribution report if \$1,000 or more is made during the late period and Forms 495/460 if \$10,000 or more is made in connection with the election. These forms are filed at the Secretary of State or county elections office, the committee's regular filing officer. ▪ Independent Expenditures: State/County committees making independent expenditures in connection with a local election held on June 7, 2011, must file Forms 496 and 465 as indicated below. The forms must be filed with the filing officer of the local jurisdiction.

Within 24 Hours <i>Late Reports</i>	5/22/11 – 6/6/11	496 497	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ 496: File if independent expenditures of \$1,000 or more are made in connection with a candidate or measure being voted upon in the June 7, 2011, election. ▪ 497: File if contributions of \$1,000 or more are made during the period in connection with a candidate or measure being voted upon in the June 7, 2011 election. ▪ Deadline: All late reports must be filed within 24 hours except the deadline for a 497 due May 28, 29 or 30 is extended to May 31. ▪ File personal delivery, guaranteed overnight service, or fax.
Aug 1, 2011 <i>Semi-Annual</i>	1/1/11 – 6/30/11	450 , or 461 and possibly 465	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ General Purpose Recipient Committees: This report is required. Use Form 460 or Form 450. ▪ Major Donor and Independent Expenditure Committees: Use Form 461. ▪ Supplemental Independent Expenditure Reports - Form 465 must be filed if independent expenditures totaling \$1,000 or more are made during the late reporting period of May 22, 2011, through June 6, 2011. ▪ The July 31 deadline falls on Saturday, so the deadline is extended to the next business day.
Jan 31, 2012 <i>Semi-Annual</i>	7/1/11 – 12/31/2011	450 , 460 or 461	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ General Purpose Recipient Committees: This report is required. Use Form 460 or Form 450. ▪ Major Donor and Independent Expenditure Committees: Use Form 461. However, if a contribution or independent expenditure was not made after June 30, 2011, this statement is not required.

- **Period Covered:** The period covered by any statement begins on the day after the closing date of the last statement filed, or January 1, if no previous statement has been filed.
- **Method of Delivery:** All paper filings are to be filed by personal delivery or first class mail unless otherwise noted.
- **Filing Deadlines:** Deadlines are extended when they fall on a Saturday, Sunday, or an official state holiday. This extension does not apply to Form 497 due June 4 or June 5 or any Form 496 report. Such reports must be filed within 24 hours regardless of the day of the week. Late statements are subject to a \$10 per day late fine.
- Local jurisdictions may impose contribution limits and additional filing requirements.
- All statements are public documents.
