Jan 31, 2012 <i>Semi-Annual</i>	thru - 12/31/11	401	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All slate mailer organizations must file this report.
Mar 22, 2012 <i>Pre-Election</i>	1/1/12 - 3/17/12	401	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> File if payments of \$500 or more are received or made to produce a slate mailer.
May 24, 2012 <i>Pre-Election</i>	3/18/12 - 5/19/12	401	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> File if payments of \$500 or more are received or made to produce a slate mailer.
Within 24 Hours <i>16-Day Reports</i>	5/20/12 - 6/4/12	498	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> File if payments of \$2,500 or more are received to produce a slate mailer in connection with the June 5 election. Deadlines: The deadline for a Form 498 reporting a late payment received on May 20 is May 21, and the deadline for a Form 498 due May 26, 27 or 28 is extended to May 29. Online filing only including non-E-Filers.
Jul 31, 2012 <i>Semi-Annual</i>	thru - 6/30/12	401	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All slate mailer organizations must file this report.

- **E-Filer:** A state slate mailer organization that has received or made payments for the purpose of producing slate mailers totaling \$25,000 or more since January 1, 2000. For more information, visit the Secretary of State's website at www.sos.ca.gov.
- **Form 401:** These reports must be filed on paper. An E-Filer also files an online/electronic report.
- **Period Covered:** The period covered by any statement begins on the day after the closing date of the last statement filed, or January 1, if no previous statement has been filed.
- **Filing Deadlines:** Deadlines are extended when they fall on a Saturday, Sunday, or an official state holiday. This extension does not apply to Form 498 due June 2 or June 3. Such reports must be filed within 24 hours regardless of the day of the week. Late statements are subject to a \$10 per day late fine.
- **Paper Filings:** All paper filings must be sent by personal delivery or first class mail unless otherwise noted.
- All statements are public documents.
- If the SMO receives payments that are not from the candidate or measure committee listed on the ballot or from a third party for the purpose of listing a candidate or measure, call the FPPC for advice.
