			<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Contributions of \$1,000 or more: A state or county committee that makes a contribution of \$1,000 or more, 90 days before the local election, must file Form 497. File with the committee's regular filing officer. ▪ Independent Expenditures of \$1,000 or more: A state or county committee that makes an independent expenditure of \$1,000 or more, 90 days before the local election, must file Form 496, Form 465, and Form 462 with the FPPC. Form 496 and Form 465 are filed with the city's filing officer. ▪ State and county committees making contributions in connection with a city election are not required to file pre-election reports on April 25 and May 23, 2013. As noted below, certain reports are due on these dates if a committee makes contributions of \$10,000 or more (Form 495) or independent expenditures of \$1,000 or more.

A Form 465 is required on July 31, 2013. ▪ 497: File if contributions of \$1,000 or more are made during the period in connection with a candidate or measure. ▪ Deadlines: File within 24 hours (see note on page 2).

May 23, 2013 <i>Special Reports</i>	4/21/13 – 5/18/13	465	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Supplemental Independent Expenditure Report: File Form 465 if the committee makes independent expenditures totaling \$1,000 or more during the period covered by the statement to support or oppose a candidate or a ballot measure being voted upon in the June 4, 2013, election. ▪ Supplemental Pre-Election Report: Recipient committees file Forms 495/460 if contributions totaling \$10,000 or more are made in connection with the June 4, 2013, election. ▪ File personal delivery or guaranteed overnight service or electronically with the committee's regular filing officer.

Additional Election Report

Depending on committee activity, the following report may also be required:

- **511 - Paid Spokesperson Report:** File within 10 days of making an expenditure totaling \$5,000 or more to an individual to appear in an advertisement to support or oppose a ballot measure.

- **Period Covered:** The period covered by any statement begins on the day after the closing date of the last statement filed, or January 1, if no previous statement has been filed.
- **Filing Deadlines:** Deadlines are extended when they fall on a Saturday, Sunday, or an official state holiday. This extension does not apply to 24-hour independent expenditure reports (Form 496) and the deadline for the Form 497 that is due the weekend before the election. Such reports must be filed within 24 hours regardless of the day of the week. Late statements are subject to a \$10 per day late fine.
- **Method of Delivery:** All paper filings are to be filed by personal delivery or first class mail unless otherwise noted.
- **Committee Status:** A county or state committee may make contributions and independent expenditures in connection with other elections. Generally, a county or state committee is one that spends more than 70% of its funds in connection with a county or state election. See FPPC regulation [18227.5](#) to determine whether your committee is a city, county or state committee.
- A committee that makes payments in connection with elections held on a date other than June 4, 2013 must consult the appropriate filing schedule.
- **Public Documents:** All forms are public documents. Campaign manuals and instructional materials available at www.fppc.ca.gov, click on the [Campaign](#) link.
- **Effective January 1, 2013, the following legislation takes effect. Check the FPPC website for updates:**
 - 24-hour contribution/independent expenditure reports must be filed during the 90 day period before an election. An additional form affirming the independent nature of the expenditure will be required. (AB 481)
 - Local agencies may require electronic filings. (AB 2452)
