- **Period Covered:** The period covered by any statement begins on the day after the closing date of the last statement filed, or January 1, if no previous statement has been filed.
- **Officeholders whose salaries are less than \$200/month and judges:** These officials do not have to file the semi-annual statements if no contributions were received or expenditures made during the period.
- **Form 470:** Candidates/officeholders who do not have a committee and do not raise/spend \$1,000 in 2013 may file an annual Form 470 on or before July 31, 2013. No additional filings required in 2013.
- **Local Elections:** If making payments in connection with another election, check the appropriate filing schedule and ordinance, if any.
- **Public Documents:** All forms are public documents and subject to late penalties. Campaign manuals and instructional materials available at [www.fppc.ca.gov](http://www.fppc.ca.gov), click on the [Campaign](#) link.
- **Effective January 1, 2013, the following legislation takes effect. Check the FPPC website for updates:**
  - Local agencies may require electronic filings. (AB 2452)
  - All committees required to file Form 410 must pay a \$50 annual fee to the Secretary of State to fund improvements in the electronic filing system. (SB 1001)
- If a committee is making independent expenditures/contributions in connection with another election, refer to that election filing schedule. In 2013, new reporting rules are in effect.

### Additional Reports

A candidate or ballot measure committee that makes political payments in connection with other elections may be required to file additional reports:

- **[460](#) - Ballot Measure Quarterly Report:** Prior to the semi-annual period in which the measure(s) supported or opposed is being voted upon, primarily formed ballot measure committees must file quarterly campaign statements in addition to semi-annual statements. Following the election, quarterly statements may also be required.
- **[465](#) - Supplemental Independent Expenditure Report:** Committees that make independent expenditures of \$1,000 or more to another candidate or measure file this report. Candidates see prohibition on previous page.
- **[496](#) - Independent Expenditure Report:** File if an independent expenditure of \$1,000 or more is made in connection with a candidate or measure being voted on in another city, county or state election in 2013.
- **[497](#) - Contribution Report:** File if a contribution of \$1,000 or more is made in connection with a candidate or measure being voted on in **another** city, county or special state election, or **made to a political party committee** 90 days before a special state election in 2013.
- Forms 496 and 497 are due within 24 hours and are required 90 days prior to an election.
