<b>Within 10 Days</b> <i>Independent Expenditure Verification</i>	Ongoing	<a href="#">462</a>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Committees making independent expenditures (“IEs”) must file this form with the FPPC – Email only no paper copy.</li> <li>Committees file only one Form 462, each election, for each candidate or measure supported or opposed by an independent expenditure.</li> </ul>
<b>Within 24 Hours</b> <i>Election Cycle Reports</i>	3/5/14 – 6/3/14	496 497	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>E-File only – no paper copy. Note: Form 497 is filed through June 2 rather than June 3.</li> <li><b>496:</b> File if an independent expenditure of \$1,000 or more is made in connection with a state or local candidate or local ballot measure being voted on the June 3 ballot.</li> <li><b>497:</b> File if a contribution of \$1,000 or more in the aggregate is received from a single source.</li> <li><b>497:</b> File if a contribution of \$1,000 or more is made in the aggregate in connection with a state candidate or local ballot measure being voted on the June 3 ballot or to a political party committee.</li> <li>The recipient of an in-kind contribution must file a contribution report within 48 hours from the time the in-kind or non-monetary contribution is received.</li> </ul>
<b>Mar 24, 2014</b> <i>Pre-Election</i>	1/1/14 – 3/17/14	<a href="#">460</a> <a href="#">465</a>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>460:</b> All committees must file this report.</li> <li><b>465:</b> File if independent expenditures totaling \$1,000 or more are made.</li> <li>The March 22 deadline falls on Saturday, so the deadline is extended to the next business day.</li> </ul>
<b>May 22, 2014</b> <i>Pre-Election</i>	3/18/14 – 5/17/14	<a href="#">460</a> <a href="#">465</a>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>460:</b> All committees must file this report.</li> <li><b>465:</b> File if independent expenditures totaling \$1,000 or more are made.</li> <li>Paper copies must be filed by personal delivery or guaranteed overnight service only.</li> </ul>
<b>Jul 31, 2014</b> <i>Semi-Annual</i>	5/18/14 – 6/30/14	<a href="#">460</a> <a href="#">465</a>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>460:</b> All committees must file this report.</li> <li><b>465:</b> File if independent expenditures totaling \$1,000 or more are made from May 18 through June 2.</li> </ul>

**Additional Reports**

- E-Filers only:  
Payments of \$5,000 or more in connection with a state ballot measure will require filing the 496/497. See form instructions. Payments may change the nature of a primarily formed candidate committee.
- Form 511:** Committees that make payments of \$5,000 or more to an individual to appear in a ballot measure advertisement must file Form 511, as a paper report - E-Filers also file online.
- Form E-530:** Committees that make a payment of \$50,000 or more for an issue advocacy advertisement must file Form E-530 *online only*, no paper copy required.

## Fair Political Practices Commission

- **24-hour Reports:** The deadline closes for primarily formed committees for state office on June 2 for contributions received or made. Form 496 must be filed through June 3.
- **Local Elections and Political Parties:** 24-hour independent expenditure or contribution reports (Forms 496 & 497) must be filed if independent expenditures or contributions totaling \$1,000 or more are made during the 90-day period prior to an election, the deadline closes June 2.
- **E-Filer:** A state committee that has received contributions or made expenditures totaling \$25,000 or more since January 1, 2000.
- **Form 460:** All state committees must file paper reports. An E-Filer also files an online/electronic report.
- **Form 496/497:** All reports filed online only.
- **Period Covered:** The period covered by any statement begins on the day after the closing date of the last statement filed, or January 1, if no previous statement has been filed.
- **Where to File:** State committees file reports with the Secretary of State. Only candidate controlled committees that are not E-Filers file paper copies with the election official at the candidate's county of domicile.
- **Filing Deadlines:** Deadlines are extended when they fall on a Saturday, Sunday, or an official state holiday. This extension does not apply to any 24-hour independent expenditure reports (Form 496) or to those 24-hour contribution reports (Form 497) that are due the weekend before the election. Such reports must be filed within 24 hours regardless of the day of the week. A \$10 per day late fine may be assessed on both the paper and electronic report resulting in a \$20/day fine.
- **Paper Reports:** All paper filings must be filed by personal delivery or first class mail unless otherwise noted.
- **Contribution Limits:** Refer to the contribution limit chart on the FPPC website.
