<b>Within 10 Days</b> <i>Independent Expenditure Verification</i>	Ongoing	<a href="#">462</a>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Committees making independent expenditures (“IEs”) must file this form with the FPPC.</li> <li>▪ Email only - no paper copy.</li> <li>▪ Committees file only one Form 462 for each candidate or measure supported or opposed by an independent expenditure.</li> </ul>
<b>Within 24 Hours</b> <i>Contribution/ Independent Expenditure Reports</i>	8/6/14 – 11/3/14	<a href="#">496</a> <a href="#">497</a>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <b>496:</b> File if independent expenditures of \$1,000 or more are made.</li> <li>▪ <b>497:</b> File if a contribution of \$1,000 or more in the aggregate is received from a single source.</li> <li>▪ <b>497:</b> File if a contribution of \$1,000 or more is made in the aggregate to <i>another</i> candidate or measure being voted upon November 4, 2014, or to a political party committee.</li> <li>▪ The recipient of a non-monetary contribution of \$1,000 or more must file a Form 497 report within 48 hours from the time the contribution is received.</li> <li>▪ File by personal delivery, guaranteed overnight service, fax or online.</li> </ul>
<b>Oct 6, 2014</b> <i>Pre-Election</i>	7/1/14 – 9/30/14	<a href="#">460</a> <a href="#">465</a>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <b>460:</b> All committees must file Form 460.</li> <li>▪ <b>465:</b> File if independent expenditures totaling \$1,000 or more are made.</li> <li>▪ The October 5 deadline falls on Sunday, so the deadline is extended to the next business day.</li> </ul>
<b>Oct 23, 2014</b> <i>Pre-Election</i>	10/1/14 – 10/18/14	<a href="#">460</a> <a href="#">465</a>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <b>460:</b> All committees must file Form 460.</li> <li>▪ <b>465:</b> File if independent expenditures totaling \$1,000 or more are made.</li> <li>▪ File by personal delivery, guaranteed overnight service or online.</li> </ul>
<b>Feb 2, 2015</b> <i>Semi-Annual</i>	10/19/14 – 12/31/14	<a href="#">460</a> <a href="#">465</a>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <b>460:</b> All committees must file Form 460.</li> <li>▪ <b>465:</b> File if independent expenditures totaling \$1,000 or more are made between October 19 and November 3.</li> <li>▪ The January 31, 2015, deadline falls on Saturday, so the deadline is extended to the next business day.</li> </ul>

## Fair Political Practices Commission

- **Period Covered:** The period covered by any statement begins on the day after the closing date of the last statement filed, or January 1, if no previous statement has been filed.
- **Filing Deadlines:** Deadlines are extended when they fall on a Saturday, Sunday, or an official state holiday. This extension does not apply to 24-hour independent expenditure reports (Form 496) and the deadline for the Form 497 that is due the weekend before the election. Such reports must be filed within 24 hours regardless of the day of the week. Statements filed after the deadline are subject to a \$10 per day late fine.
- **Method of Delivery:** All paper filings are filed by personal delivery or first class mail unless otherwise noted. A paper copy of a report is not required if a local agency requires online filing pursuant to a local ordinance.
- **Local Ordinance:** Always check on whether additional local rules apply.
- **Public Documents:** All forms are public documents. Campaign manuals and instructional materials are available at [www.fppc.ca.gov](http://www.fppc.ca.gov), click on the [Campaign](#) link.
- **Form 511 - Paid Spokesperson Report:** File within 10 days of making an expenditure totaling \$5,000 or more to an individual to appear in an advertisement to support or oppose a ballot measure.
