Local Slate Mailer Organizations
June 3, 2014 Election**

Jan 31, 2014 <i>Semi-Annual</i>	thru – 12/31/13	401	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All slate mailer organizations must file this report.
Within 24 Hours <i>Payment Reports</i>	3/5/14 – 6/2/14	498	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> File if payments of \$2,500 or more are received to produce a slate mailer in connection with the June 3 election. File by personal delivery or guaranteed overnight service only.
Mar 24, 2014 <i>Pre-Election</i>	1/1/14 – 3/17/14	401	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> File if payments of \$500 or more are received or made to produce a slate mailer. The March 22 deadline falls on Saturday, so the deadline is extended to the next business day.
May 22, 2014 <i>Pre-Election</i>	3/18/14 – 5/17/14	401	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> File if payments of \$500 or more are received or made to produce a slate mailer.
Jul 31, 2014 <i>Semi-Annual</i>	thru – 6/30/14	401	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All slate mailer organizations must file this report.

- **Period Covered:** The period covered by any statement begins on the day after the closing date of the last statement filed, or January 1, if no previous statement has been filed.
- **Method of Delivery:** All paper filings are filed by personal delivery or first class mail unless otherwise noted. A paper copy of a report is not required if a local agency requires online filing pursuant to a local ordinance.
- **Filing Deadlines:** Deadlines are extended when they fall on a Saturday, Sunday, or an official state holiday, except for the Form 498 due the weekend before the election. Statements filed after the deadline are subject to a \$10 per day late fine.
- If the SMO receives payments that are not from the candidate or measure committee listed on the ballot or from a third party for the purpose of listing a candidate or measure, call the FPPC for advice.
