Feb 2, 2015 <i>Semi-Annual</i>	thru - 12/31/14	401	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ All slate mailer organizations must file this report. ▪ The January 31, 2015 deadline falls on a Saturday, so the deadline is extended to the next business day.
Jul 31, 2015 <i>Semi-Annual</i>	1/1/15 - 6/30/15	401	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ All slate mailer organizations must file this report.
Feb 1, 2016 <i>Semi-Annual</i>	7/1/15 - 12/31/15	401	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ All slate mailer organizations must file this report. ▪ The January 31, 2016 deadline falls on a Sunday, so the deadline is extended to the next business day.

- **Period Covered:** The period covered by any statement begins on the day after the closing date of the last statement filed, or January 1, if no previous statement has been filed.
- **Method of Delivery:** All paper filings are filed by personal delivery or first class mail unless otherwise noted. A paper copy of a report is not required if a local agency requires online filing pursuant to the local ordinance.
- **Filing Deadlines:** Deadlines are extended when they fall on a Saturday, Sunday, or an official state holiday. Statements filed after the deadline are subject to a \$10 per day late fine.
- **Local Elections:** If the SMO receives payments in connection with a local election in 2015, use the filing schedule for that particular election to determine the deadlines for filing pre-election statements.
- If the SMO receives payments that are not from the candidate or measure committee listed on the ballot or from a third party for the purpose of listing a candidate or measure, call the FPPC for advice.
