<b>May 7, 2015</b> <i>IE Report</i> <i>(General)</i>	4/5/15 – 5/2/15	<a href="#">465</a>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Paper filing and online for E-filers.</li> <li>▪ Paper filing must be sent by personal delivery or guaranteed overnight service only.</li> <li>▪ File if independent expenditures totaling \$1,000 or more are made to support or oppose a candidate on the May 19 ballot.</li> </ul>
<b>July 31, 2015</b> <i>Semi-Annual</i>	* – 6/30/15	<a href="#">461</a> & possibly <a href="#">465</a>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Paper filing and online for E-filers.</li> <li>▪ <b>461</b>: All committees must file this report.</li> <li>▪ <b>465</b>: File if independent expenditures totaling \$1,000 or more are made and have not been previously reported.</li> </ul>

- **This filing schedule is prepared for the special election only. Committees making payments in connection with other elections may trigger other reporting deadlines.**
- **\*Period Covered:** The period covered by any statement begins on the day after the closing date of the last statement filed or January 1 if no previous statement has been filed.
- **Odd Year Report:** File by April 30, 2015 if contributions totaling \$10,000 or more are made to committees controlled by elected state officers between January 1, 2015 and March 31, 2015.
- **Form 496:** 24-hour independent expenditure reports must be filed through March 17 for the primary election and May 19 for the general election.
- **Form 497:** Unlike the 24-hour independent expenditure reports (Form 496), the deadline for 24-hour contribution reports (Form 497) closes March 16 for the primary election and May 18 for the general election.
- **E-Filer:** A state committee that has received contributions or made expenditures totaling \$25,000 or more.
- **Forms 461 & 465:** All state committees must file an original and one copy in paper format by personal delivery or first class mail unless otherwise noted. An E-Filer also files an online/electronic report.

- **Filing Deadlines:** Deadlines are extended when they fall on a Saturday, Sunday, or an official state holiday. This extension does not apply to any 24-hour independent expenditure reports (Form 496) or to 24-hour contribution reports (Form 497) that are due the weekend before the election. Such reports must be filed within 24 hours regardless of the day of the week. A \$10 per day late fine may be assessed on both the paper and electronic report resulting in a \$20/day fine.
- **Contribution Limits:** Contributions to state candidates and to committees that make contributions to state candidates are subject to contribution limits. Refer to the [contribution limits chart](#) on the FPPC website. Committees making “issue ads” featuring state candidates are also subject to contribution limits.
