Fair Political Practices Commission Filing Schedule For State Major Donor, State Independent Expenditure and State General Purpose Recipient Committees, Other than Political Party Committees, For the March 2, 2021 and May 4, 2021 Senate District 30 Special Primary and Special General Elections

- The 90-day election cycle begins December 17, 2020 for the March 2, 2021 Special Primary.
- The 90-day election cycle begins February 3, 2021 for the May 4, 2021 Special General.
- Contributions and independent expenditures of \$1,000 or more that are made to or in connection with a candidate being voted on in a special election listed above, or made to a political party committee, must be reported within 24 hours. See Forms 497, 496, and 462 for more information. *Note: Once the California Access Replacement System (CARS) is live, the Form 462 will no longer be required.
- State general purpose recipient committees (other than political party committees), are not required to file regular preelection statements (Form 460) in connection with the SD 30 special elections.
