This will confirm your recent advice on the following matters:


1. Bronze Eagle donated to Governor's office for limited term.

You advised that a bronze sculpture provided to the Governor's office for use during a specified period of time would not be reportable as a gift to the Governor. You also recommended that the owner of the sculpture express in writing the terms and conditions under which the sculpture is made available to the office.

2. Expenses incurred by a public official in connection with attendance at a fundraiser.

You advised that food, lodging and air travel provided to a public official who is invited to attend a political fundraiser would not ordinarily be reportable as a gift by the official. Rather, the official's attendance at the fundraiser is considered adequate consideration for reasonable travel expenses incurred in connection with such attendance.

I trust that this memorandum accurately summarizes our conversations on these matters. If any of the statements expressed herein are not correct, please so advise as soon as possible.
