Dear Ms. Roquemore:

This is in response to your letter of April 30, 1984, which asked whether the Alta-Dena Political Action Committee must report on its campaign disclosure statement (Form 420) a dinner provided to a legislator and his spouse and, if so, on what schedule would the expenditure be reported?

Although the dinner does not constitute a "contribution" as defined by Section 82015 of the Political Reform Act (Government Code Sections 81000-91014), Section 84211 requires that recipient committees report all receipts and expenditures. Therefore, if PAC funds were used to pay the cost of the dinner, the expenditure must be reported on Schedule E (Payments) of the PAC's campaign disclosure statement. If the expenditure was made out of non-PAC funds, however, the PAC would not be required to report the activity.

In addition, regardless of whether or not the expenditure was made out of the PAC's funds, if the Alta-Dena Certified Dairy is the employer of a lobbyist, the expenditure must be reported as an activity expense in Part 2, Section C of its Report of Lobbyist Employer (Form 650).
