Dear Ms. Tavlin:

Thank you for your letter of June 1, 1984, regarding whether the activities of the Long Beach Republican Review are reportable under the Political Reform Act (Government Code Sections 81000-91014). You indicated that the Review is a televised talk program which does not support or oppose specific candidates or ballot measures, and does not make contributions to or expenditures on behalf of candidates or measures, but merely discusses general political topics such as fundraising, conventions, etc. Such activities are not regulated by the Act and are, therefore, not reportable.

Enclosed for your information are a copy of the Political Reform Act, the Commission's information manual on the campaign disclosure provisions of the Act, and Commission regulations 2 Cal. Adm. Code Sections 18215 and 18225, which explain the types of payments that are reportable under the Act's campaign disclosure provisions.

GENERAL PROGRAM TREATMENT - LONG BEACH REPUBLICAN REVIEW

- I. Purpose: To bring forth to the community different facets of the Republican Party and information regarding their programs and activities by interviewing guests whose involvement pertains to a weekly theme, trying to highlight Long Beach Republicans whenever possible.
- II. Theme: The theme will vary each week.
Goal - To present this information in an informative and positive fashion and to pick topics that are of general interest.
- III. Description of the Program : Format - Informal Interview
The program will be co-hosted by Linda Tavlin and Wendy Offill. We will have informal question of either two or three sets of guests. That will vary with the weekly topic. After the questioning we will have informal discussion. We will then break and return with the next set of guests. The same procedure will be followed throughout.
Format will be as follows:
I. Introduction the the show title (Long Beach Republican Review) and co-hosts (Wendy Offill and Linda Tavlin)
A. Statement of program segment topic
B. Introduction of guests (Group A)
II. Interviewing
A. Questions from hosts to guests
B. Open discussions between guests and hosts
C. Thanking of guests and closing
III. Break
IV. Return
The same procedure is to be followed for the remaining guests whether there are two or three sets of guests.
V. End of program
- IV. Floor Plan: We will be using the studio set. There will be four chairs around a small table with the microphone set in the middle of the table. Lighting and camera placement to vary according the the director.
- V. Budget: We will use the studio equipment and tape.
