Dear Ms. Crooks:

This letter will formally confirm my previous telephone advice to the effect that you may treat the disclosure category for the Senior Vice Chancellor-Administration, San Francisco Campus as being 4 and 17, rather than 1. The assignment of category 1 was a clerical error when your office rearranged the order of designated officials and resulted in one campus' official being treated differently than like officials on all other campuses. This would be inappropriate. Therefore we will treat the category as being 4 and 17 for this annual report and will correct the clerical error when the Code is revised next fall.

Dear Bob:

As we discussed on March 13, there is a typographical error in Appendix A of the University's approved 1985 Conflict of Interest Code. The disclosure category for the Senior Vice Chancellor-Administration, San Francisco Campus (page 15 of the printed Code) is shown as 1, and it should have been 4 and 17. All Vice Chancellors-Administration have been designated as 4 and 17 categories in past Codes, and with the exception of the San Francisco Vice Chancellor are so indicated in our 1985 Code.

Appendix A was originally sent to you for review on November 15, 1984, and the 4 and 17 categories were correctly listed for the San Francisco position. Appendix A, with only a revised order of designated officials, was again sent to you on November 21, 1984, and this is the copy on which the typographical error was made.

Following our discussion, I have informally advised the Senior Vice Chancellor-Administration at San Francisco to complete his statement of economic interest using the originally intended disclosure categories of 4 and 17. By this letter, I am asking you for a formal advice letter to officially correct the error.

I am sorry this happened, and, as always, appreciate your helpful assistance.
