SUBJECT: Political Reform Act Reporting Obligations

This will confirm our telephone conversation of May 1, 1985 regarding the Governor's reporting obligation with respect to donated aircraft services which were utilized for a personal trip. Although we did not discuss the nature of the trip, you may be interested in knowing that the trip was taken to attend a relative's funeral.

You advised that the usual rules pertaining to reimbursement for air transportation apply to personal as well as State business or campaign trips: If the Governor reimburses the provider of the transportation at the scheduled commercial air rate, there is no obligation to report the value of the trip on the Governor's Statement of Economic Interests.

Thank you for your advice on this matter.
