Dear Larry:

This letter will confirm our telephone conversation of today about the requirement for Justice Kaus to file a Leaving Office Statement of Economic Interests. You indicated that Justice Kaus resigned as a full time member of the Court approximately a week ago and immediately began to serve as a pro tem judge, which he will continue to do until sometime in December. I advised you that since there was no break in service, Justice Kaus is not required to file a Leaving Office Statement now, but will be required to file within 30 days of the date that he leaves the position of pro tem judge (Gov. Code Section 87205 and FPPC Regulation 18724).
