Dear Mr. Hempel:

This is to confirm the advice provided to you last month by Colleen McGee of this office regarding the termination of your status as a lobbyist.

As I understand the facts, you ceased all activities as a lobbyist and ceased receiving payments for lobbying as of December 31, 1985. However, because of some confusion resulting from the special re-registration process conducted earlier this year, you did not file a Statement of Termination. You asked if you must complete the 1986 registration forms and file a disclosure report for the first quarter of 1986 in order to terminate at this time.

Ms. McGee advised you, and this will confirm, that you may file the enclosed Statement of Termination (Form 606) at this time and may use December 31, 1985, as the date of termination. No registration statements or first quarter disclosure reports need be filed for 1986 so long as you did not engage in lobbying activities and did not receive any payments for lobbying after December 31, 1985.
