Dear Ms. Zumwalt:

Thank you for your letter dated May 15, 1986, in which you asked for clarification of the lobbying disclosure provisions as they apply to Mr. Willie Hausey. You stated the following:

Mr. Willie Hausey is an "in-house lobbyist" employed full-time by Watts Health Foundation. Mr. Hausey formed a lobbying firm of which he is president, and contracts with one lobbyist to lobby for the clients of this firm.

Because Mr. Hausey is owner of a lobbying firm, Mr. Hausey must register and file reports as a "lobbying firm," and not as an "in-house lobbyist." In addition, Watts Health Foundation should terminate its lobbyist employer registration because it employs a lobbying firm, and entities which employ a lobbying firm are not required to register.

Mr. Hausey may, if he wishes, explain on his registration statement and on his quarterly reports that he is a full-time employee of Watts Health Foundation and that he does not personally provide any lobbying services for the clients who contract with Willie Hausey & Associates.

Mr. Hausey's registration as a lobbying firm should be effective as of the date of this letter. It is not necessary to amend the previous quarterly reports filed by Watts Health Foundation or the previous quarterly reports filed by Willie Hausey & Associates.


Dear Ms. Pirchard:
