Dear Mr. Loomis:

Thank you for your letter dated July 11, 1986 which transmitted the semiannual statement for the the Committee to Elect Judge William Seelicke. In your letter you asked for clarification on the filing semiannual reports by an elected judicial officeholder with a controlled committee.

Government Code Section 84200(a)(2) states that "...judges, judicial candidates, and their controlled committees shall not file semiannual statements pursuant to this subdivision for any six-month period in which they have not made or received any contributions or made any expenditures."

Therefore if Judge Seelicke or the Committee to Elect Judge William Seelicke does not receive contributions or make expenditures for political purposes, a semiannual campaign report is not required to be filed.

I hope this information is helpful to you. Enclosed is a copy of the Political Reform Act of 1974 as Amended to January 1, 1986 for your use. Please feel free to contact our office if I can be of any further assistance.

Greetings:

Please find enclosed the required filing for JUDGE William H. Seelicke of the Antelope Valley Municipal Court.

On page 4 of your instructions, under A you state that elected officeholders must file, and on page 8 under 'exceptions to filing pre-election statements' you say that...officeholders who..receive less than 500 during the entire year..may file Form 470, which was not included in the packet.

To obtain some clarification of this contradiction, I called your Los Angeles office and the people I talked to simply did not know the answer to this question, but advised me to file, just to be sure!

No money has been raised by or for Judge Seelicke since 1982. His remaining funds have been placed in the bank and are drawing interest. He will not run again until 1988. Is it necessary to send in 12 pages of documentation every 6 months to report a few dollars of simple interest?
