Dear Carla:

This letter is to confirm our recent conversations on the matter of two \$200.00 receipts by the committee that are a bit out of the ordinary, and your advised reporting procedures for each.

As you recall, both \$200.00 receipts were received from our 1986 primary opponent's staff people who were arrested for stealing Quackenbush campaign signs. As a result of a civil compromise agreed upon by the staff people and Chuck Quackenbush, each staff person was to pay \$200.00 to the committee (the committee was the victimized party) for restitution for the crime.

Through our conversations, you advised me on the following:

1. Both \$200.00 receipts are to be reported as "Miscellaneous Adjustments to Cash Position". An explanation of the receipts will be included on the FPPC report.
2. The one receipt which was cash was deemed legal and receivable by you in that it was not a "contribution".
