You have asked for advice concerning the duties of Senator Dan Boatwright under the mass mailing provisions of the Political Reform Act.<sup>1/</sup>

The Commission's Legal Division does provide written advice to persons with questions about their duties under the Political Reform Act. (Section 83114(b).) We do not provide advice to third parties about another person's duties unless the third party has been authorized to request advice by the person whose duties are in question. (Regulation 18329(b)(8)(B).) Therefore, we cannot provide advice on the question you have raised. However, I have referred your letter to our Enforcement Division for review.
