FACTS The spouse of a city councilman died after a prolonged illness. On or about the time of the funeral ceremony, a unknown male left \$2,000 in cash in the mortuary office with the verbal instructions to contribute the money toward the costs of the funeral.

- QUESTIONS
1. Is the gift reportable by the city councilman on his statement of economic interests?
  2. If yes to above question, how should it be reported?

- ANSWERS
1. Yes, it is reportable on the filer's statement of economic interests as a gift.
  2. List the date and the amount of the gift and list the source as "unknown." Include an explanatory note about why the source is unknown.
