I am writing to confirm the oral advice you gave me concerning an Assemblymember who wishes to advertise a secretarial job that is available in his office. You advised me that, pursuant to regulation 18901, the member may place an advertisement in the newspaper, provided that the advertisement does not mention the Assemblymember's name or indicate in which Assemblymember's office the job is available. The advertisement may, however, list the Assemblymember's office telephone number, but only if the number is not identified as being the Assemblymember's number.

I would appreciate written confirmation of this advice.
