This letter is to confirm our conversation of June 13, 1989. As per our conversation, I understand:

- 1) The provisions of Proposition 73 are not violated when a mass mailing exceeding 200 pieces per month is paid for (including all production and mailing fees) with contributions raised after January 1, 1989 that have been identified and deposited in an account that specifies the office for which the funds are to be used, in this case: Morgan for Senate '92, ID# 890213.
- 2) It is allowable to include a pre-printed request card for voter registration materials in this mailing, which the recipient may use to request a voter registration form from their County Registrar of Voters.
