Dear Ms. Pritchard:

The purpose of this letter is to confirm our telephone conversation of July 20, 1989 concerning the filing obligations under the Political Reform Act for the above-referenced committee.

In our telephone conversation I advised you that the Progress In the 90's, A Garamendi Committee was a recipient committee registered with the Secretary of State earlier this year for the purpose of qualifying and supporting the passage of a state-wide ballot measure to amend the Gann limit in the state constitution. In prior oral advice given to me as treasurer for that committee, you indicated that because the committee was a ballot measure qualification committee, the committee would not be required to file a semi-annual campaign report on or before July 31, 1989 for the period ending June 30, 1989.

In our most recent telephone conversation I advised you that on July 10, 1989, Governor Dukemejian signed bills that included legislation to place on the state ballot next June a measure which would amend the Gann limit. This legislative ballot measure would accomplish precisely the goal for which the Progress In the 90's committee originally was established.

Consequently, the Progress In the 90's committee's purpose will no longer be the qualification of a state-wide ballot measure. Instead, the committee will expend funds in support of the passage of the measure.
