California Elections Code.

American Independent Party County Central Committee Div. 7 pt. 4 Article 4.
§ 9,745. Dues

Each committee may establish annual dues not to exceed twenty-four
dollars (\$24) per year for elected, exofficio and alternate
members. The committee may **not** remove members or alternates
for nonpayment of dues.

Recall General Provisions & Initial Steps Div. 16 Ch. 1. Article 1.
§ 27,000. Application of division

This division governs the recall of elective officers of the State
of California and of all counties, cities, school districts, county
boards of education, community college districts, special districts,
~~and~~ judges of courts of appeal and trial courts, **and political parties.**

It does not supersede the provisions of a city charter or county
charter, relating to recall.
