Dear Mr. Yager:

You have requested confirmation of telephone advice provided to you on behalf of the Yes on Sutter Fire Measure "A" Committee concerning the campaign disclosure provisions of the Political Reform Act.^{1/}

Your letter, dated September 25, 1989, correctly states the advice I provided to you that the Yes on Sutter Fire Measure "A" Committee is not required to file Form 420. A recipient committee is any person, organization or entity which receives contributions totaling \$1,000 or more in a calendar year. (Section 82013(a).) You have stated that your committee will not receive \$1,000 in the calendar year. You should write to the Secretary of State and your county clerk with whom you filed the Form 410 and advise them that you will not qualify as a recipient committee and that you would like to rescind the Form 410 that you previously submitted. As long as you do not qualify as a committee, you will not have any filing obligations under the Act. A copy of your letter is enclosed for your convenience.



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
