This is in response to your request for information concerning American Independent Party candidates for statewide offices.

Candidates must file a candidate intention statement (Form 501) with the Fair Political Practices Commission prior to soliciting or receiving any contributions. In addition, they are required to open campaign bank accounts and file campaign bank account statements (Form 502). (Gov. Code Section 85201.) However, the law does not require candidates to list party affiliation on these forms. Enclosed is a copy the printout which shows the names of all candidates for statewide office.


Dear Mr. Szychowski:
