Dear Ms. Child:

This is in response to your request for confirmation of telephone advice concerning the campaign disclosure provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act").¹

This will confirm my advice to you that the activities of Citizens Allied for a MultiPurpose Unified School (CAMPUS) have not resulted in the organization qualifying as a committee under the Act. I advised you to file a Statement of Termination (Form 415) with the Secretary of State.

If the unification measure is approved by the State Department of Education for placement on the ballot and CAMPUS begins raising funds to support the measure, it will incur filing obligations as a committee if it receives or makes contributions totaling \$1,000 or more, or makes independent expenditures totaling \$1,000 or more, during a calendar year.



Dear Ms. Taylor:

Thank you for the time you spent on the telephone with me on Tuesday. I appreciate your help with our questions. I am writing to confirm our conversation and to request a written confirmation from you as to the status of our committee, Citizens Allied For A Multi-Purpose Unified School (CAMPUS).

As I explained over the telephone, our committee's goal is to form a unified school district in Foster City. To achieve this goal we have submitted petitions to the San Mateo County Board of Elections. These petitions, if verified, will bring our request to the San Mateo County Committee on School District Organization and then to the State Department of Education. The verification of the signatures will not automatically qualify our request for the ballot. That can only happen after approval of the State Department of Education.

Based on the above information, you recommended that we file a Statement of Termination for our committee since it does not qualify as a recipient committee and should never have been filed as such. I have filed this statement (Form 415) with the Secretary of State as of this date. I would appreciate a written confirmation to the above details from you for our records. Again, thank you for your help.
