Dear Mr. Pescetti:

This is in response to your request for advice regarding the Political Reform Act (the "Act") and the California Political Reform Act of 1996 ("Proposition 208"). 1

QUESTION

When may you begin raising campaign funds for the 10th Assembly District 1998 election under the new provisions of Proposition 208?

CONCLUSION

Effective January 1, 1997 (the effective date of Proposition 208), you may begin raising contributions once the fundraising window for the 1998 campaign opens. Under your fact pattern, you may begin raising contributions six months before the primary or regular election.

FACTS

You have filed the appropriate forms to register as a candidate for the 10th Assembly District in the 1998 election and you are inquiring when you may begin raising campaign funds.

Government Code Sections 81000-91014. Commission regulations appear at Title 2, Sections 18110-18995 of the California Code of Regulations.

<u>ANALYSIS</u>

Proposition 208 was passed by the voters on November 5, 1996, and became effective January 1, 1997. Pursuant to Section 85305(a), candidates or the candidate's controlled committee in districts of fewer than one million residents may accept contributions beginning six months before the primary or regular election.
