Dear Mr. Logue:

The Fair Political Practices Commission ("Commission") enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act") found in Government Code Section 81000, and following. As you are aware, the Commission received complaints against you alleging that you violated the contribution disqualification provisions of the Act found in Section 84308 and the relevant Commission regulations. The complaints allege that you made, participated in making, or influenced decisions involving a license, permit, or other entitlement for use in 2004, 2005, and 2006, while serving as an appointed member of the Three Rivers Levee Improvement Authority ("Improvement Authority") and the Yuba County Local Agency Formation Committee ("LAFCO"). The Commission has decided to close this case without further action.

The complaints allege that you received contributions from multiple entities, including developers, then voted in favor of granting these entities various entitlements and contracts. Our investigation revealed that even though you did receive various campaign contributions from these entities, none of the relevant votes met all of the elements necessary to find a violation of Section 84308. Therefore, we are closing this case without finding a violation.
