The Fair Political Practices Commission ("Commission") enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act").<sup>1</sup> As you are aware, the Commission initiated an investigation regarding the allegation that you may have violated the prohibition against conflicts of interest when you, as Chair of CalOptima, directed staff to assist in projects on behalf of Managed System of Care.

The Enforcement Division has determined that there is insufficient evidence to find that you violated the Act in this particular circumstance. Therefore, we have decided to close this matter.
