Dear Judge Kopp:

The Fair Political Practices Commission (the "FPPC") enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act"),<sup>1</sup> found in Government Code section 81000, et seq. As you may be aware, the FPPC had received a complaint against you alleging you violated the Act.

The FPPC has completed its investigation of the complaint filed against you in the above-referenced matter. The complaint alleged that you violated the Political Reform Act's limitations and disclosure provisions on the receipt of gifts and travel by failing to disclose international travel undertaken as a member of the California High Speed Rail Authority. If true, this potentially was a violation of the Act's gift and travel reporting and limits provisions.

Our investigation has determined that there is no evidence that you committed a violation of the Act. As a result, we are closing this case without taking any further action.

The FPPC publishes forms and manuals and maintains a Technical Assistance Division to facilitate compliance with the requirements of the Act.
