Dear Ms. Saucerman:

The Fair Political Practices Commission ("Commission") enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act")¹ found in Government Code Section 81000, and following. As you may be aware, the Commission received complaints alleging violations of the conflict of interest provisions of the Act regarding governmental decisions you made in your capacity as the Yountville Mayor in connection with your vote to approve the Yountville budget.

Based on our review and investigation of this matter, we have determined that your vote to approve the Yountville budget was permissible. (Regulation 18709, subd. (c).) As such, there is no basis for a conflict of interest violation under Section 87100 of the Act. Therefore, our file in this matter has been closed.
