Dear Mr. Stern, and Re-Elect Stern – 2007:

The Fair Political Practices Commission (the “Commission”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”)<sup>1</sup> found in California Government Code Section 81000 and following. On November 16, 2007, the Commission received a complaint alleging violations of the campaign disclosure provisions of the Act regarding Douglas Stern’s re-election campaign for Rancho Palos Verdes (RPV) City Council in the November 6, 2007 election.

Based on our review and investigation, we determined that you: 1) did not receive expenditures or non-monetary contributions from Palos Verdes on the Net (PVNET) because PVNET’s website and email services were offered to all candidates for RPV City Council; 2) did not receive reportable expenditures or non-monetary contributions as defined in the Act from the City of Rancho Palos Verdes toward Mr. Stern’s 2007 re-election campaign.

Therefore, we have determined that you did not violate the Act, and our file in this matter has been closed.
