The Fair Political Practices Commission (the "Commission") enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act")<sup>1</sup>. The Commission opened an investigation into allegations that your client SEIU State Council violated several sections of the Act including Section 85301, subdivision (a), by coordinating on expenditures made in support of Prophet Walker, an unsuccessful candidate for the 64<sup>th</sup> Assembly District in the November 4, 2014 general election.

The Enforcement Division of the Commission has completed its investigation into the allegations and found insufficient evidence to demonstrate a violation of the Act. As a result, we are not pursuing an enforcement action in this matter and are closing this matter with this letter.
