The Fair Political Practices Commission (the "FPPC") enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act"),¹ found in Government Code section 81000, et seq. As you are aware, the FPPC began a pro-active investigation against the San Bernardino City Professional Firefighters PAC ("SBCPF PAC") because of an alleged failure to file campaign disclosure statements with the City of San Bernardino. After review of the allegation, the FPPC has found no violation of the Act.

According to the allegation, the SBCPF PAC failed to file campaign statements since 2009. However, after contact from the Enforcement Division, you provided copies of campaign statements filed with the City of San Bernardino from 2009 through 2012, including copies of postal receipts for the mailings.
