Case Closure Letter Re: FPPC No. 12/332, James Penman

Dear Mr. Penman:

The Fair Political Practices Commission (the "FPPC") enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act"),¹ found in Government Code section 81000, et seq. As you are aware, on June 5, 2012, the FPPC opened an investigation based on allegations that you violated the Act by accepting a gift above the gift limit and failing to disclose that same gift on your 2010 Annual Statement of Economic Interests.

The Enforcement Division of the Commission has completed its investigation into the allegations, and has found no evidence that you violated the gift provisions of the Act. Therefore we are closing this case without further action.
