Dear Mr. Schroder:

The Fair Political Practices Commission ("Commission") enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act") found in Government Code Section 81000, and following. As you may be aware, the Commission was investigating whether you were in violation of the conflict of interest provisions of the Act because you allegedly participated in governmental decisions in which would have a material financial effect of persons who served as a source of income to you.

After conducting a full investigation and reviewing the evidence gathered, we have determined that there is no evidence to find you violated the Act. As a result, we are closing this case with this letter. Specifically, we determined that the alleged source of income to you was not, in fact, a source of income to you. Thus, no conflict as to that source of income could have ensued.

The Commission publishes forms and manuals to facilitate compliance with the provisions of the Act and provides guidance regarding filing obligations over the telephone and through written advice.
