Dear Mr. Yonehiro:

The Fair Political Practices Commission ("Commission") enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act") found in Government Code Section 81000, and following. As you may be aware, the Commission was investigating whether you were in violation of the Act's prohibition against influencing prospective employment because you allegedly participated in the procurement of a contract for a law firm for whom you were negotiating with for future employment.

**After a full investigation, we have determined that there is no evidence to find you violated the Act. As a result, we are closing this case with this letter.**

The Commission publishes forms and manuals to facilitate compliance with the provisions of the Act and provides guidance regarding filing obligations over the telephone and through written advice.
