Dear Mr. Wilson:

The Fair Political Practices Commission (the "FPPC") enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act"),<sup>1</sup> found in Government Code section 81000, et seq. As you may be aware, the FPPC had received a complaint against you alleging you violated the Act.

The FPPC has completed its investigation of the complaint filed against you in the above-referenced matter. The complaint alleged that you failed to timely report a contribution from the Orange County Republican Party and that expenditures made by the California Republican Party for consulting services were made for consulting services for your campaign during the 2008 election period.

Our investigation has determined that there is insufficient evidence to determine that you committed a violation of the Act. As a result, we are closing this case without taking any further action.

The FPPC publishes forms and manuals and maintains a Technical Assistance Division to facilitate compliance with the requirements of the Act.
