Dear Ms. Haley:

In regards to the warning letter issued to you regarding the above-referenced case, please be advised that the Fair Political Practices Commission ("FPPC") is hereby withdrawing the warning letter and closing the case.

The FPPC enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act found in Government Code Section 81000, and following, including provisions regarding filings by committees of late contribution reports. A complaint was filed against you for not filing the required late contribution report and we closed your case with a warning letter. However, subsequently, you submitted proof in the form of a facsimile completed transaction report demonstrating you had sent the required late contribution to the City of Saratoga in a timely fashion. The City Clerk of Saratoga has confirmed the facsimile number used is correct. The FPPC has changed its conclusion of the case to a finding of no violation of the Act.
